Matter: Information about job vacancy – Researcher at the Department of international research projects – ERA Chair

The rector of the University of Žilina would like, according to directive no. 158 *Principles of the selection procedure for positions of university teachers, positions of researchers, functions of associate professors and professors and managing employees of the University of Žilina*, **invite applications for two vacant positions of Researcher at the Department of international research projects – ERA Chair of the University of Žilina.**

Qualification:

- Finished third level of university studies (PhD. or equivalent) in technical or scientific area relevant to Transport/Mobility including ITS and ICT.

Requirements:

- Experience in EU-funded projects (e.g. FP/H2020 projects) in relevant areas such as Mobility Behaviour; Transport Economics; Transport Planning; Environmental Impact Assessment
- Publication record in high-impact conferences and peer reviewed journals
- Advanced analytical, writing and presentation skills
- Knowledge of statistical methods and software applied to transport/mobility data analysis
- Excellent organisational skills and ability to set and meet deadlines
- Ability to work in autonomous way, cooperative and supportive team player, proactive attitude
- Proficiency in MS Office programmes (MS Word, Excel, Powerpoint, Outlook)

Desirable:

- Thematic expertise on one or more of the following areas: Value of Travel Time (VTT), transport mode choice, time use and perception, travel experience
- Previous experience in project management (i.e. Project Coordinator, WP Leader)
- Familiar with open science (e.g. data curation, open data, research data management)
- Knowledge of EU research and innovation policy in transport/mobility sector

Work description:

The researcher will contribute to the H2020 project Mobility and Time Value (MoTiV), which aims at advancing research on Value of Travel Time (VTT) by introducing and validating a conceptual framework for the estimation of VTT through a European-wide data collection producing scientific and policy outcomes, as well as potential business developments. <http://motivproject.eu>

Specifically, the researcher is expected to:

- Lead and contribute to the preparation of high-impact scientific publications based on the analysis of the data collected within the project
- Have a major role in developing the theoretical basis and an innovative methodology to estimate VTT from the viewpoint of the traveler
- Initiate and support the dissemination and exploitation of the project results by attendance of relevant events and through online dissemination (e.g. web-site, social media)
- Assist with the preparation of internal reports, deliverables and other project outputs
- Support the organization of project events

Work Place: University of Žilina, Slovak Republic

Conditions:

- 1-year contract until October 2020, with possibility of extension;
- Monthly salary range: 1,700 – 3,000 EUR
- 30 days annual leave per annum prorated;
